**CrossRoad Orthodox Summer Institute:** Scholarships Available for Diocesan Students Attending CrossRoad Orthodox Summer Institute. The Diocesan Chancery is pleased to announce that registration is now open for the 2018 CrossRoad program. CrossRoad is a ten-day academic summer institute that prepares high school juniors and seniors to make big life decisions and invites them to connect with the Orthodox Christian theological and spiritual tradition. Participants from all over the country come together to experience daily worship, take theology classes from some of the best professors in the country, visit local parishes, serve their neighbor, tour the city, and even spend a day at the beach. The sessions are as follows: Session 1 - June 16 – June 26 (Boston) Session 2 - July 2 – July 12 (Boston) Session 3 - July 21 – July 31 (Chicago). Scholarships covering the registration and tuition fee will be available to our Diocesan students who apply and are accepted to any one of the three sessions.
