There is a Lenten Renewal Retreat at Holy Resurrection Orthodox Church in Belle Vernon on February 17th. The information is posted downstairs.

Lenten services – We will have the Moleban to Cross on Wednesdays during lent and a bible study immediately following the service (bring your own bible - old and new testament). We will be studying the scriptural readings of lent, especially the Sunday readings. On Fridays, we will have the Pre-Sanctified Liturgy and will be rotating some of these services with the other local Orthodox parishes. A schedule will come later.

This Week: As we make our final preparations for Lent, today is traditionally the last day that we eat meat until Pascha. This is why it is called “Meat-fare Sunday” – i.e., “Bye-bye to Meat.” This traditionally helps us ease into the strict fasting of the Great Lent. We call this week “Cheese-fare Week,” (“Bye-bye to Dairy”) since this is the last week we would traditionally eat dairy products before Pascha. It ends in Cheese-fare Sunday (Forgiveness Sunday), the day before the beginning of the Great Lent.
