After that, we are called to kneel in prayer and services during the week at the appropriate times. We are also permitted to kneel on Sundays, because of long-standing custom, but we all know of course that the actual rule is that we never kneel on any Sunday, since every Sunday is the celebration of the Holy Resurrection
