Mon., September 11 – Feast of the Beheading of St. John the Baptist. We remember this event recounted in the Gospel of Mark 6:14–30. John was a holy prophet and an innocent man. His beheading was a preview of the crucifixion of Our Lord, the Innocent Lamb Who is greater than all the prophets. **A Fast from meat and dairy** is observed on this day in commemoration of the murder of the man Jesus called, “the greatest man born of woman.” Also, in commemoration of the way that St. John was martyred, pious Orthodox will not eat from a plate but only from a bowl, will not use knives to eat with, and will not eat foods that are round or come as a ‘head’ (cabbage, lettuce, etc.).
